Subject: Road Work Request

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We request assistance from the Washington County Road Department on the road work we have planned for this year. Included are three street improvements and some sidewalk extensions. In the three road projects, we only plan for grading and base work this year. We will postpone chip-seal until future funds allow it.

The roads requiring grading/gravel are:

S. Valley Road from Mulberry to Pecan about 4 inches additional road base approx. 0.1 mile

N. Valley Road from Cherry to end of right-of-way approx. 0.1 mile removal of debris, grading, sub-base (3 in. stone) and 6 inches of road base

Pecan Street from Main to I-15 right-of-way about 4 inches additional road base

approx. 0.1 mile

Also, if possible, we would like your help on our sidewalk project. We have a UDOT Safe Sidewalk grant to extend our Main Street Sidewalk up to Vista Avenue. In addition to providing a safe sidewalk, we have UDOT approval for removing a very hazardous condition where an irrigation ditch crosses Main Street.
