Minutes of the Town Council Meeting July 23, 2003

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Norma Gier called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### 2. ROLL CALL:

Present was Mayor Norma Gier, Council Members Darrell Nelson, Gloria Parnell, Dave Harbour and Dale Barnes.

#### 3. PLEDGE:

Darrell Nelson.

# 4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA AND MINUTES OF JUNE 25, 2003, WORK SESSION AND TOWN COUNCIL MEETING:

Motion by Gloria Parnell to approve the agenda and minutes of June 25, 2003. Seconded by Dale Barnes. Passed unanimously.

### 5. PUBLIC HEARING (MOTION TO OPEN AND CLOSE):

Ordinance No. 03-07 to Adopt Leeds Outdoor Light Ordinance. Motion by Dale Barnes to open the public hearing. Seconded by Gloria Parnell. Passed unanimously.

Discussion by Council Members. Need verification that lumens specified in ordinance are correct. Correct typo's etc.

Comments from Leeds residents. <u>LeGrand Forsyth</u> concerned that misdemeanor being too severe punishment for infraction. <u>Dianne Houston</u> asked about how the ordinance would affect existing lighting in Town. Council Member Nelson responded that "grandfathering" would apply. <u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to close the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

#### 6. ACTION ON PUBLIC HEARING:

Motion by Dave Harbour to table Ordinance #03-07 until all typo's and lumen amount in paragraph 4.4. B can be cleared up. Seconded by Darrell Nelson. Roll call vote. All ave votes. Motion passed unanimously.

## 7. PUBLIC HEARING: (Motion to open and close)

Ordinance No. 03-08 Leeds Billboard Ordinance. Motion by Darrell Nelson to open the public hearing. Seconded by Dave Harbour. Motion passed unanimously.

Leeds Billboard Ordinance No. 03-08 was read by Darrell Nelson. Council discussed that this ordinance has been worked on and reviewed for several years. No further comments or questions. <u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to close the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Motion passed unanimously.</u>

#### 8. ACTION ON PUBLIC HEARING:

Motion by Dale Barnes to adopt Leeds Billboard Ordinance No. 03-08.

<u>Seconded</u> by Darrell Nelson.. <u>Roll call vote.</u> <u>All aye votes.</u> <u>Motion passed unanimously.</u>

#### 9. PUBLIC HEARING: (Motion to open and close)

Ordinance No. 03-09 to grant the petition and annex Silver Reef Addition.

Motion by Gloria Parnell to open the public hearing. Seconded by Dale Barnes.

Passed uanimously.

Ordinance No. 03-09 was read. The Council felt annexing Silver Reef would be beneficial to the Town and to Silver Reef residents. **Dave Clements** of Silver Reef made several comments concerning the process they have gone through in order to petition for this annexation. He was asked by Dave Harbour about the order of the process of referring building permit applications to the architectural control committee of Silver Reef after the Town has approved. Harbour expressed that the architectural control committee should approve first, then refer applicant to the Town. Dave Clements said that the architectural control committee is yet to be designated. Presently Silver Reef Special Service District board members serve in that capacity. **Motion** by Dave Harbour to close the public hearing. **Seconded** by Gloria Parnell. **Passed unanimously.** 

#### 10. ACTION ON PUBLIC HEARING:

Motion by Dave Harbour to adopt Ordinance No. 03-09 Annexation of Silver Reef Addition pending the switching of the order of approval of building permits, architectural control committee approval and then the Town approval. (Sixth point on summary) Seconded by Gloria Parnell. Roll call vote. All ave votes. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 11. MAYOR NORMA GIER:

Mayor Gier referred to a newspaper article of July 18, 2003, concerning how St. George handles zoning violations.

Mayor Gier reminded everyone of only one Town Council meeting in August on the 4th Wednesday.

#### 12. COUNCIL MEMBER DARRELL NELSON:

#### Planning Commission items:

- a) Bert Leany request approval of a lot line adjustment. Bert Leany has requested a lot line adjustment on his property. The Planning Commission has recommended approval. Motion by Gloria Parnell to approve the lot line adjustment for Bert Leany. Seconded by Dave Harbour. Passed unanimously.
- b) Silver Reef Highlands Subdivision-Discussion Only. This was a discussion only item at the Planning Commission meeting. Council Member Dave Harbour expressed concern about the open space area and recommended 2 acre zoning so that the open space areas are actually owned by the homeowners. Also, this subdivision may landlock an area to the north that may one day be developed.

#### 13. COUNCIL MEMBER GLORIA PARNELL:

Parnell informed the Council there has been vandalism of the park restrooms. Officer Nelson recommended signs be posted stating "no overnight camping, no loitering, no alcohol, violators will be prosecuted." Parnell said she is looking into re-painting the

faded center line on Silver Reef Road.

#### 14. COUNCIL MEMBER DAVE HARBOUR:

Harbour said he is working on updating the Town road map. Harbour said the flood plain map was rescinded in 2/2/84 and Leeds is classified zone C, so there is no flood plain issue here.

Harbour presented a summary of the resident surveys that were sent out the first of this month. So far he has received back 39 surveys. (See attached survey summary).

#### 15. COUNCIL MEMBER DALE BARNES:

Barnes discussed park landscaping and possibly adding some rocks. Barnes said he was able to contact the owner of the property bordering the park. The owner said he gave the Town 30ft. along the property line and later gave access to connect Valley Road to Babylon.

Barnes said a map of Hurricane ATV trails, both established and proposed, could be posted at Town Hall for the public to view and to solicit suggestions.

#### 16. ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
