Minutes of the Town Council Meeting and Work Session October 13, 2004

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Norma Gier called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL:

Present was Mayor Norma Gier, Council Members Gloria Parnell and Dale Barnes. Council Members Dave Harbour and Darrell Nelson were excused.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

4. APPROVE AGENDA AND MINUTES

<u>Motion</u> by Dale Barnes to approve tonight's agenda. There were no minutes available for approval. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

5. ERICK PITZENBURGER:

Request waiver of Zone Change fees. Mayor Gier stated the issue Pitzenburger is having with his property has been discussed extensively at previous meetings. A brief review was given. Pitzenburger purchased a ½ acre lot from Keith Steele. However Keith Steele had not gone through the process of splitting his property. Since the property is also in a 1 acre zone, Steele not only did an illegal lot split but it was also a non conforming lot. Pitzenburger took on the responsibility of making the lot split legal by submitting a minor subdivision plat. He also requested the zone change since he purchased a ½ acre lot in a 1 acre zone. The Council discussed the expenses the Town has incurred concerning legal notices and staff time concerning the minor subdivision and zone change request.

<u>Motion</u> by Dale Barnes to refund \$700 of the \$1,000 Pitzenburger has paid for the zone change application. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Roll call vote. All aye votes. Motion passed unanimously.</u>

6. WORK SESSION:

Discussion items for Work Session.

Zoning/Subdivision Ordinances. The Planning Commission tabled this at their last meeting encouraging the members to review before the next meeting. The Council had nothing further at this time since Council Members Harbour and Nelson were not present.

Fee Schedule. The Mayor encouraged the Council to look over the fee schedule and see if there are any changes they would like to consider.

Capitol Improvement Plan. The Council discussed several ideas for the 1 and 5 year action plan. One of the suggestions was to consider purchasing a backhoe for the Town.

BLM Public Purposes Land. Maps of the BLM property were distributed to the Council Members and the Mayor sent the BLM a letter.

Irrigation Pipe Project. Brent Gardner from Alpha Engineering called the Mayor and told her the Leeds Irrigation Company will pay their share of the cost. The start date is scheduled

for sometime in December.

October 27th has been set for the public hearing date to annex the State of Utah School and Institutional Trust Lands North West of Town and also to to open and amend the budget for the curb and gutter expenditure on Main Street.

Minutes of the Town Council Meeting and Public Hearing October 27, 2004

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Norma Gier called the meeting to order at 7:00

2. ROLL CALL:

Present was Mayor Norma Gier, Council Members Darrell Nelson, Gloria Parnell, and Dave Harbour. Also present was Attorney Heath Snow and Clerk/Recorder Joy Stevens. Council Member Dale Barnes was excused.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

4. APPROVE AGENDA AND MINUTES OF OCTOBER 13, 2004:

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to approve the agenda and minutes of the Town Council Meeting on October 13, 2004. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

5. OATH OF OFFICE TO NEW DEPUTY RECORDER:

Clerk/Recorder Joy Stevens administered the Oath of Office to Pauline Fowlks as the new Deputy Recorder.

6. PUBLIC HEARING: (Motion to open and close)

Resolution #04-05 to open and amend the 2004-2005 budget to reflect an increase in fund expenditures in the amount of \$21, 965.00 for Main Street improvements.

<u>Motion</u> by Darrell Nelson to open the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Dave Harbour. <u>Passed unanimously</u>. Mayor Gier updated everyone concerning Washington Co. Water Conservancy District pipeline in conjunction with the Leeds Water Company pressurized irrigation pipe line. The Town has been asked to contribute \$21,965.00 for the curb and gutter portion of the project. The open ditch is a hazard and at least 2 children have drowned in it. This ditch will be covered in this project.

Comments from Council Members: Dave Harbour stated this will be money well spent. Darrell Nelson asked if the property owners will have a say in where the pressurized irrigation connection to their property is located. Gloria Parnell asked if any utility poles will need to be moved. Mayor Gier asked Brent Gardner, Alpha Engineering representative, for a time line of phases and when the project will start. Gardner said the property owners will have a say concerning the location of the connection for the pressurized irrigation system. Gardner said there may be changes to grades on driveways and entries into some properties. Gardner said they will not be moving any utility poles. Main Street will have a center turn lane. Gardner stated a time line has not yet been set.

There were no comments from the public.

<u>Motion</u> by Darrell Nelson to close the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously</u>.

7. ACTION ON PUBLIC HEARING:

Motion by Gloria Parnell to approve Resolution #04-05 to open and amend the 2004-2005 budget for the expenditure of \$21,965.00 for the Main Street project. Seconded by Darrell Nelson. Roll call vote. All aye votes. Passed unanimously.

8. PUBLIC HEARING: (Motion to open and close)

Ordinance #04-06. An Ordinance annexing the area known as "SITLA NE ANNEXATION"

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to open the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously</u>.

Mayor Gier read Ordinance #04-06. Council Member Darrell Nelson asked if there were any roads on this property. SITLA representative Curt Gordon said there are no roads but there are existing right-of-ways. Ken Miller explained the location of the property, and stated that the trust lands are participating with Silver Reef Highlands concerning the water tanks. Council Member Dave Harbour expressed concerns about septic systems and the density in the area. Curt Gordon said these concerns are more appropriate during the subdivision phase. No zone has been designated yet. Gordon stated a plan and zone request will be presented after annexation. Attorney Snow reminded the Council that this area is in the Master Annexation Plan for Leeds. The property is contiguous to the Town of Leeds and does not create an island. Snow said even if the Town does not annex this property they will still bear the burden. There were no protests filed during the protest period.

There were no comments from the public.

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to close the public hearing. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

9. ACTION OF PUBLIC HEARING:

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to approve Ordinance #04-06 and annex the area known as "SITLA NE ANNEXATION". <u>Seconded by Gloria Parnell.</u> <u>Roll call vote.</u> <u>All aye votes.</u> <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

10. COUNCIL MEMBER DARRELL NELSON:

Nelson had nothing further at this time.

11. COUNCIL MEMBER GLORIA PARNELL:

Babylon Road project. Parnell handed out an estimate prepared by Bush and Gudgell Engineering. The project will be done in phases. The first phase will be to remove the large trees and then grade and cut the ditches. Parnell will get more bids for the tree removal before the next meeting.

12. COUNCIL MEMBER DAVE HARBOUR:

Harbour submitted, for the Town files, the Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation of LDWA. Harbour inquired whether several new businesses in Town had obtained a business license. The businesses in question had all obtained a license. Harbour asked the Council Members to continue their review of the new zoning ordinances.
