1. Call to order

e. Elliott Sheltman on LDWA water tank.

Elliott Sheltman- Gave update on improvements that would be made to the proposed office space for LDWA. He asked Council for their input on how to get approval to start construction and for some clarity to Ordnance's.

- 1. Joe Allen Being a shareholder in LDWA, does this make sense financially to put money into the tank for office space verses finding a space already improved?
- 2. Elliott Sheltman LDWA needs office space. The improvements would be a 2 year project. The location is great and will put LDWA in a permanent location.
- 3. Wayne Peterson Would like time to review parking ordinance.
- 4. Frank Lojko Asked Elliott if he looked at the building codes and suggested he contact Dennis Mertlich.

Council members would like Elliott to do more research and make sure he is in compliance with building codes.
