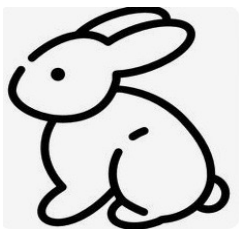

## Leeds Town General Plan Update

The Town General Plan is on track. This plan is a requirement for the town to obtain funds, manage our budgets, as well as affirm we are in alignment with citizens. General Plans serve as an advisory, living document that provides direction and focus for the community's growth and development.

Sunrise Engineering has been employed to help the Town of Leeds facilitate this plan. A key component of developing this plan includes obtaining feedback from the town's citizens. This was performed with the Town Survey, last December. The results of the survey are available on the Town's website.

We are also working with our town planner, the planning commission, the steering committees, additional stake holders of the town, as well as possible developers, to provide input and direction as the plan is drafted.

Please continue to stay engaged during Planning Commission meetings and Town Hall meetings, to keep your voices heard, as well as surfacing any concerns about the direction of the plan.
