Town of Leeds ORDINANCE NO. 2008-03

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE LEEDS OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ORDINANCE NUMBER 2006-10 WILL DESIGNATE MAIN STREET AS AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ROUTE.

WHEREAS, under recent legislation passed in Utah State Code, section 41-22-10.5, a municipality or county may adopt ordinances designating certain streets and highways under its respective jurisdiction as open for general off-highway vehicle use; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town of Leeds to allow OHV access on Main Street from the Town's southern boundaries to its northern boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Town appreciates the importance OHVs play as a source of recreation for the residents of Leeds, as well as a tool to explore the surrounding beauty of the area; and

WHEREAS, the Town discussed the importance of having Main Street be a designated OHV route at a previous Town Council meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEEDS, UTAH THAT THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT SHALL BE ADOPTED:

Revise paragraph C. "Designation of Streets", to read as follows:

<u>Designation of Streets and Highways:</u> Pursuant to the authority granted to the Town Council in Section 41-22-10.5, Utah Code Annotated, all Town streets are hereby designated as off-highway vehicle routes to allow off-highway vehicles, except for those routes which are specifically posted as closed to off-highway vehicle use. Main Street, from the southern border of the Town to the northern border, shall also be designated as an official off-highway vehicle route.

This Amendment to Ordinance 2006-10 shall become effective immediately upon passage.

Ordinance 2008-03 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Leeds Town Council on the 26^{th} of March, 2008, by the following vote.
