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### 10. Discussion Items:

### a. Recycling plan in Washington County

Councilmember Rohr discussed curbside recycling. There are 3 options for the service;

- 1. Mandatory with the cost estimated around \$3.00 a month per household.
- 2. Opt Inn (you want the service) estimated around \$7.00 a month per household.
- 3. Opt Out (available I don't want the service) somewhere between \$3.00 to \$7.00 a month per household.

Councilmembers discussed it further.
