TOWN OF LEEDS

Minutes of the Town Council Meeting November 9, 2005

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Gier called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL:

Present was Mayor Norma Gier, Council Members Dave Harbour, Gloria Parnell, Dale Barnes, and Brent DeMille. Also present was Attorney Heath Snow and Clerk/Recorder Joy Stevens.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

4. APPROVE AGENDA AND MINUTES:

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to approve the agenda and minutes, of October 25, and October 26, 2005. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

5. AARON WALL-UDOT PROJECT MANAGER:

Approval of engineering firm for the Main Street beautification project. Mayor Gier updated everyone concerning the Main Street Enhancement Grant. Project manager LoAnne Barnes introduced Aaron Wall from Utah Dept. of Transportation, and Tom Christensen from Jones and DeMille Engineering. Aaron Wall explained the grant stating it is a unique grant administered with federal highway money. Wall said UDOT has worked with Jones & DeMille as consultants on many projects. The scope of the project was presented by Tom Christensen. Christensen said the total for Design/Environmental is approximately \$47,747.68. Both gentlemen stated there is a lot of red tape to do this project. Wall explained that UDOT has a "pool" of engineers they work with and Jones & DeMille Engineering is in the pool. Wall said every 2 years they allow engineering firms the opportunity to apply to the UDOT pool.

The Council discussed landscapers giving the Town what they want and not something exotic they don't want. Christensen said the landscape architects will meet with the Town to look at the project and see what the Town desires. Wall stated they would like to move ahead with the contract and approve Jones & DeMille as the engineering firm.

<u>Motion</u> by Dale Barnes to allow proceeding with the contract with Jones DeMille Engineering. <u>Seconded</u> by Gloria Parnell. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

6. TABLED ITEMS FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING ON OCTOBER 26, 2005:

Approve Leeds OHV Ordinance #05-08. The Town Council tabled this item at the last meeting so the final"draft" could have all the revisions added. Mayor Gier asked the members if they have had a chance to look at the revised ordinance. The members indicated they had and there was no further discussion.

Motion by Brent DeMille to approve OHV Ordinance #05-08 as is currently written.

Seconded by Gloria Parnell. Roll call vote. All aye votes. Passed unanimously. Council Member Brent DeMille asked if there was any in put after the ordinance was posted. Mayor Gier

inquired if anyone had received any input. No one had received any in put.

7. SILVER CREEK ESTATES (FORMERLY CIBOLO ESTATES):

Submit a Planned Unit Development Application and Subdivision Preliminary Plat for property located in the area north of Silver Reef Road between Bonanza Estates and Silver Reef Highlands Subdivisions. The Planning Commission recommended approval at their last meeting. Drake Howell of the State of Utah Institutional Trust Lands introduced himself and Curt Gordon, Project Engineer Ken Miller, Landscape Architect Dave Bell and Attorney Lowrey Snow. Howell said they would like to present the plan and ask the Council to have a public hearing on December 14th. Howell was given time for a power point presentation. The presentation touched on the name change, the Master Plan consisting of 45 lots ranging in size from 1 ½ to 4 acre lots, of the 115 total acres 25% is planned as open space, a will serve letter from LDWA, and a feasible letter from Southwest Health concerning septic tanks. Curt Gordon said they would like to vary from the typical road, in order to preserve the edge of the road and the tender landscaping. The Council voiced concern over deviating from the standards Leeds has set concerning roads. Council Member Dave Harbour noted several errors that needed to be corrected. in the CC&R's. Discussion then focused on roads, connecting roads, on street parking, trails, improvements and dedication of the park, and dry sewer being brought to the lowest point.

<u>Motion</u> by Dave Harbour to set a public hearing for December 14, 2005. <u>Seconded</u> by Brent DeMille. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>

8. MAYOR NORMA GIER:

Mayor Gier presented a Certificate of Appreciation to John & Elsie Beck. The Becks held another yard sale with all proceeds being donated to the town park. The first yard sale donation was over \$1200.00 and this one was a little over \$1300.00. Everyone expressed their appreciation to the Becks for all they do for the community.

9. COUNCIL MEMBER DALE BARNES:

Council Member Dale Barnes reviewed the information items from the last Planning Commission meeting.

Attorney Heath Snow commented on Home Occupation Businesses. Snow said the nature of the business needs to be looked into. If it is not a permitted or a conditioned use in the zone applied for then the license should not be approved.

Barnes said he would like to set up a trap shooting range on BLM property in the vicinity of property owned by Roger New. The Council discussed liability issues, and access to the property. Barnes will check into this further.

10. COUNCIL MEMBER GLORIA PARNELL:

The Council discussed the road damage in the El Dorado Hills area and Bonanza Flats Road. Qwest will be covering the exposed phone lines. Parnell said base rock will cost approximately \$500.00 for 20 tons.

<u>Motion</u> by Gloria Parnell to approve up to \$500.00 for the base rock. <u>Seconded</u> by Brent DeMille. Roll call vote. All aye votes. Passed unanimously.

11. COUNCIL MEMBER DAVE HARBOUR:

Submit for approval the "draft" amendment of the Capital Facilities Plan for Public Safety and Parks. Council Member Harbour updated the Council on the revisions that have been made to the Capital Improvement Facilities Plan. When the current plan was adopted in 1997 the fire department was under the jurisdiction of the Town. The references to the fire department have been removed. The Council discussed the level of service and required facilities for public safety and parks. It was suggested the impact fee for parks be \$1300.00 and the impact fee for public safety at \$525.00. Harbour asked the Council members to review the draft and submit any changes or suggestions to him by the end of the month.

<u>Motion</u> by Dale Barnes to table this item for the next meeting. <u>Seconded</u> by Dave Harbour. Discussion. Harbour said he would like to have the comments in to him early enough to amend the ordinance and have a public hearing on December 14th.

<u>Motion</u> by Dale Barnes to amend his previous motion to include setting a public hearing date for December 14th. <u>Seconded</u> by Dave Harbour. <u>Passed unanimously.</u>
