8. Action Items:

 a. Approval of Tentative Budget for 2016-2017 General Fund and Capital Improvement Fund and setting of Public Hearing date.

Mayor Peterson, we need to set a Public Hearing date, the proposed Public Hearing date would be two weeks from tonight on May 25th, then on June 8th the approval of the Final Budgets.

Town Council discussed the highlights from the 2016-2017 Tentative Budgets. The following amendments were made to the General Fund expenses:

- 1. \$600.00 added to sanitation for Dumpster Days to compact the trash in the Dumpsters.
- 2. \$1500.00 added to highways and streets for gravel on the east side of Cherry Lane.

Mayor Peterson asked for a motion to approve the Tentative Budget amended with an additional \$600.00 that will be put into compaction services for Dumpster Days and \$1500.00 for road maintenance and repair; which will increase the projected surplus that would be brought in to \$15,543.00.

I was in a meeting earlier today where there is a thought that maybe there is a ways to address the short term rental in communities limiting it, more than prohibiting it. There are going to be some draft suggestions as to how that could be done, circulated by some of the other Towns that are looking into this. I will keep people up to date with regard to it.
