4. Action Items:

a. Canvass of the 2017 Municipal Election for the Town of Leeds

Kim Hafen the Clerk/Auditor from the County indicated on Wednesday, November 8^{th} , 12 ballots were received at the County from the Leeds Post Office that were postmarked November 9^{th} . His first thought was they were supposed to be date stamped the 6^{th} , and the stamp was upside down with a 9th. They got in contact with the St George postmaster, who followed through with some of this for them, and that is the case with those twelve ballots. A further complication with that is, they were able to identify 8 of those that they could recognize the November 9^{th} on them, the other four, the stamp is placed in such a way, they could not be identified, but they assume where they all came together with the Leeds postmark that they were all mailed on the 6^{th} postmarked the 9^{th} .

Kim and Councilmembers discussed it and Kim indicated Councilmembers would have to decide whether they would want to count the ballots or not.
