A RESOLUTION OF LEEDS TOWN COUNCIL ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2017-2021

WHEREAS the Town Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Town of Leeds, Utah, and

WHEREAS the Town of Leeds, Utah, has participated in the creation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereinafter known as the Five County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017-2021, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the Five County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017-2021 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Town of Leeds, Utah, from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and
